



AUTO THEFTS & VANDALISM ON THE RISE: WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Park smart & in well-lit areas.

- Avoid parking in areas that are not well lit or places that are not immediately seen by passers-by. We recommend parking under a light and in a well-trafficked area.
- Park inside a garage or behind a locked gate.

Lock vehicle doors.

- Keeping the doors locked is a great habit and the first step in discouraging a thief from continuing a break-in.

Remove car keys from the vehicle.

- If the key is left in the car or ignition, a thief can simply break-in and drive off. Even if when running into the store for a quick errand, never leave the keys inside the vehicle.



Don't leave valuables in the car.

- One way to attract a thief is to leave any items of value in a visible place in the car. It's best to leave anything of value, including change, at home or hidden.

Install GPS tracking.

- If the vehicle is stolen, a tracking system will emit a signal to the police or monitoring system of the vehicle's location.
